The CT Department of Labor (DOL) is offering a reimbursement to companies in Eastern Connecticut who are training their workforce. Upgrading the skills of the workforce is key to remaining competitive in this economy, and we can help!

Apply for an Incumbent Worker Training Grant Today!

Program features:

- You choose the training program, training provider and employees to be trained.
- The grant equals 50% of your training project or activity. For example, the grant would equal \$10,000 for a training project that costs \$20,000.
- Company must be up to date on all state taxes and be OSHA compliant to be eligible for funding.
- Paperwork is minimal. A Department of Labor Business Consultant will service your grant from start to finish.

Due to a limited amount of funding, Training Grants are awarded on a competitive basis. Priority will be given to applications that meet the following:

- Economically vital industries that employ workers in high growth occupations. These industries include, but are not limited to: Advanced Manufacturing, Healthcare, Finance & Insurance, and Bioscience.
- High growth organizations that are committed to creating career ladders for their front line employees, provide a safe and healthy workplace, and provide wages and benefits that exceed industry averages.
- Training programs that assist workers in obtaining skills to start or move up their career ladders. This may include training designed to increase the basic skills of employees, training in written and oral communication, mathematics or science, and training in technical and technological skills.
- Companies that have not received Incumbent Worker Training funds in the past three years.
